Consideration is given to other issues relevant to this age group such as transitions, awareness of diagnosis and the development of coping strategies. Case studies, working examples, photocopiable checklists, assessment forms and session sheets are provided.

Forty photocopiable activities are included, which target the developmental areas and are tailored to suit the competence of the young person. The book also suggests a number of community visits to help the group transfer their skills from a clinic-based to a real-life setting.
