This book discusses what it was like to get polio, her experiences with various hospitals and doctors, and her experience in Warm Springs. The book is a straight chronicle of her experiences. The book describes the service delivery system at the time and the book touches upon gender roles (what it was like to be a woman with a disability at that time).
